Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 POP Declaration

Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (as part of the REACH Regulation) on persistent organic pollutants aims to restrict the use and release of certain persistent organic pollutants. These can remain in the environment for a long time, accumulate in living organisms and have serious health and environmental impacts. The Regulation replaces the previous Regulation (EC) No 850/2004.

Substances from Annex 1 of the POPs Regulation are prohibited, those from Annex 2 are restricted and substances from Annexes 3 and 4 are subject to the provisions on release reduction and waste management.

Based on the information provided by our suppliers, we confirm that none of the banned substances listed in Annex 1 of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 are contained in the printed circuit boards manufactured by us and that restrictions on other substances in accordance with the Regulation are complied with.
